signals of a heart attack and cardiac arrest, how to react, and how to provide CPR, greatly improving a person's chance of survival Conventional Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation Conventional CPR involves chest compressions (pushing hard and fast on the centre of the chest) and artificial respiration (rescue breathing or mouth-to-mouth breaths)
